Bidding and Purchasing Procedures:

1. If you have pre-registered, please pick up your bidding packet when you arrive. It will contain your personalized bid number(s) and a blank purchase order (PO). Please write your name and bid number(s) on the PO. *Note: You may use one PO per family.
2. If you have not pre-registered, please register when you arrive to obtain your bid number and blank PO. You will need one bid number per person. (This bid number is used to match up each individual with the parties and events you sign up for.) Please give complete and accurate contact information even if you think it is in the church directory.
3. As the evening progresses, please record ALL purchases from the Live Auction and the Silent Auction. Do not record Raffle winnings on the PO.
4. At the end of the evening, take your PO to the closing tables where it will be totaled and your cash, check, MasterCard or Visa accepted. (Sorry, No American Express or Discover Card).
5. **You must be present to win a prize.** You need to show your raffle ticket to claim your raffle winning. **All unclaimed raffles will be combined for a final DOOR PRIZE that is awarded at the end of the evening.**

Raffle

A variety of items and services will be raffled during the evening. These items are listed in the catalog. Raffle tickets may be purchased at the registration table, from Marge Horton, who will be offering tickets by the bar, and from our volunteers who will be walking around selling tickets to guests.

Ticket Prices are:

An Arms-Length = \$20

***BONUS- If you purchase an arms-length of tickets, you are entitled to an additional arms-length of tickets for \$5 by heading over to our ticket table at the bar and showing Marge Horton that you purchased them, she'll give you another arms-length!**

Live Auction

Various donated goods and services will be sold through our live auction. Some of the items have a minimum bid set by the donor. Once the auctioneer calls 'sold,' the bidding is over, and the item or service is awarded. The decision of the auctioneer is final. **In the event that there are two of the same items or services being offered, they will be awarded to the two highest bidders at the final bid price.** If you are the winning bidder, display your bid number for the auctioneer and record your winning bid on your PO.

Door Prize

Each attendee will be given one door prize ticket. Your bid/ticket number is on the stub. Place the stub in the basket at the registration area when checking in. The Door Prize will be drawn as we conclude our Live Auction. **NOTE: You must be present when your ticket is drawn to win.**

Silent Auction

Please only use your bid/ticket number when making your bid for all Silent Auction items. No names are required. Please increase the bid by at least the noted increment on the bidding sheets.

The Silent Auction will close near the end of the 2nd Live Auction session; the end will be announced 10 minutes, and again 5 minutes in advance. Winners will then be revealed. **Please be sure to record your winning bid on your PO.**
